STEP #1:

REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS have been included in this packet for your RESOURCE only. Print these and hand them out to your students to fill out. You collect them and register your students online. **TIP:** Be sure and collect applications from your students 1-2 weeks before the registration deadline so that YOU can get them registered on time. **DEADLINE IS MARCH 3, 2025**

STEP #2

Pro-Tips for Leaders

#1 - Read the Rule Book

The Rule Book is **the most** important tool in achieving a Superior Rating at any Fine Arts Festival. Minor penalties can accrue big point values. Each leader, as well as, each student participating, needs to read the Rule Book to ensure all of the requirements are met. You can download the 2025 Fine Arts Rule Book at www.rmdc.org/finearts/

#2 - Appoint a Fine Arts Coordinator

Whether it's you or someone from your group, appoint someone who loves the details to coordinate the registrations, practices and plans that make Fine Arts a success.

#3 - Make Copies of Registration Forms

These copies are for your students to fill out and give back to **YOU** to register them online. They do not need to complete the church information in section two since that will be the same information for each student.

#4 - Host a Dress Rehearsal

One of the best ways for students to fine tune their performance is hosting a dress rehearsal. Whether you call it a Practice Festival, Showcase or something totally unique, your students will gain from the performance and the local church will enjoy seeing what the students are doing.

#5 - Bring ALL STUDENTS to Youth Convention

Not all students want to compete but by encouraging them to attend Youth Convention along with the performances, they will get exposure to Fine Arts PLUS they will encounter God by attending the evening Youth Convention Services.

#6 - Start Promoting Early

It's never too early to start promoting Fine Arts. The students need time to make a plan, gather team members and practice. Start early!
